“The Nutcracker” the most beloved title by all audiences in a version, set in Tim Burton’s films, signed by Fredy Franzutti.

Clara’s dream, the battle of the mice, the fantastic journey, are narrated in Tchaikovsky’s Christmas tale, conceived on Hoffman’s story “The Nutcracker Prince and the Mouse King”. The show by Fredy Franzutti, one of the most appreciated choreographers on the national scene, effectively combines the testimonies of the original staging by Petipa – Ivanov (first choreographers of “The Nutcracker”) with a new dramaturgical structure inspired by the gothic world of director Tim Burton reconstructed by sumptuous scenes and spectacular costumes.

The beautiful musical themes that come to life with the festive scenes under the Christmas tree, make the ballet a title particularly loved by the audience, even by the very young, for its reference to the warm family atmospheres of Christmas. The interpreters of this Nutcracker are the dancers of the Balletto del Sud, a solid international reality achieving great success in numerous Italian and European tours since 1995 – the year of its foundation.
